

**PORT OF LEWISTON
RESOLUTION NO. 14-2
TAX LEVY AND BUDGET HEARING**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Port Commission of the Port of Lewiston, Idaho, that there be, and is hereby levied, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2014, a tax upon all taxable property within the Port District of the Port of Lewiston, in mills and portions of mills, sufficient to raise the sum of \$450,000.00 by means of such tax levy; the same being the total tax levied for all Port District purposes, except the payment of the principal and interest of the general bonded indebtedness of the Port, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2014, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing upon the proposed budget of the Port of Lewiston for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2014, be held at the Port District Office, 1626 Sixth Ave North, Lewiston, County of Nez Perce, State of Idaho, on Wednesday, June 11, 2014, at the hour of 7:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and that notice of such hearing be posted in the following places within the district:

At or near the front door of the offices of the Lewiston Orchards Irrigation District, Lewiston, Idaho;

At or near the front door of the Lewiston City Hall, Lewiston, Idaho;

At or near the front door of the Nez Perce County Courthouse, Lewiston, Idaho;

At or near the front door of Valley Foods, Lapwai, Idaho;


At or near the front door of the United States Post Office, 102 N. Main Street, Peck, Idaho.

That said notice be posted at least 10 days prior to such hearing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Port Attorney prepare and cause to be published a copy of the proposed budget, together with a Notice of Hearing thereon, in the Lewiston Morning Tribune at Lewiston, Idaho, as provided by law.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a copy of said proposed budget shall be available for public examination from and after the posting of Notice of Hearing, at the office of the Port District, 1626 Sixth Ave North, Lewiston, Idaho, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12 o'clock noon and 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. of every day not a legal holiday.
